Key Discussion Points

WA Feral Pig Strategy completed, now onto implementation phase

WA Feral Pig Advisory Group – first meeting in Feb – 63 attended. Advisory Group to be established by the middle of the year with at least 2 meetings per year

How do we measure impact and reward land managers?

More data needed on distribution of feral pigs / where groups are actively involved or concerned - a number of groups doing great work

How to support passionate community champions?

- Recognised Biosecurity Groups
- State NRM Funding rounds

Andrew Knight – Research consultant - Engage universities in data collection — Uni of Qld work on access resource allocation — use to identify value of investment

Pest management is predominantly a **people issue**. Costs of effort for people – consider stress, fear, mental health impacts – *we need to work together*

Funding - Funding avenues for pigs and pests continue to be intermittent pulse funding - Constant effective management needs consistent funding.

More support/ongoing funding is needed from government – all landholders need to be involved – suggestion to have a coordinated and collaborative approach, possibly across LGA/catchment boundaries
